

UJI students design 13 video games inspired by climate change

Student of the Universitat Jaume I (UJI) of Castelló presented this morning at Menador Cultural Space the design of the 13 video games inspired by climate change, an initiative that forms part of Living Lab Planeta Debug, co-financed by the Daniel and Nina Carasso Foundation. This video game exhibition has also been organised within the framework of the Climate Change Observatory sponsored by the environmental management company Fobesa, part of the Gimeno group. Nine of these games are based on lines of research of scientific groups of the UJI, while another four are of free theme and educational nature.
